This Sunday Jim Churcher will lead our regular All-Age service on the subject of 'Prayer', drawing on Luke 11. Next week Rev Ruth will lead a service on the subject of 'Mission' drawing upon Colossians 1:1-14.

On 29th October the clocks go back an hour, giving you an extra hour in bed before our 9.30am service led by Dan Jenkins at which Rev Ruth will preach on 'The Bible' based on 2 Timothy 3:10-17.

Engage Worship Workshop coming to CtK



On Saturday 25th November, Christ the King will be hosting Sara and Sam Hargreaves from *Engage Worship* who will be leading a workshop on the theme of '**The rest is worship**'. This is about Jesus' invitation to rest in him.

Beginning at 10.00am, the morning session will include sung worship, reflection, teaching and discussion around the themes of *The Rest Is Worship*. After lunch, there are two optional tracks: one is a retreat-style exploration on Christian rest and reflection and the other is exploring practically what it looks like to lead gathered worship on God's invitation to rest. The workshop will finish by 4.00pm.

As we are hosting this event, those in our congregation at Christ the King **have free entry**. For others the cost is £15 each.
