There are 3 recycling bins in the kitchen:

- A blue bin for clean paper and card only.
- A green bin for hard plastic, tin cans and glass. Do not put broken glass in here.
- A red bin for soft plastic only.
- There is also a blue plastic crate in the foyer for recyclable paper and card only.

Please do not put broken glass in the recycling bins. Anything that cannot be recycled should go in the cream kitchen general waste bin. Please wrap up broken glass.
