Steve Potter and Fr Mark.

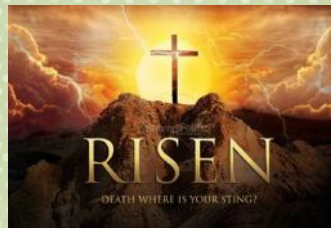


EASTER SUNDAY
