2026 Children and Youth Church arrangements

From the beginning of next year we are trying out a new arrangement for younger and older children during our morning services.

For children who have not started Reception year at school, if they wish, parents can take them into the Narthex to supervise their child while participating in the service, with the service sound fed via a speaker.

For school age children, our Children's Church will take place in the Community Centre Hall (except for services intended for all ages and the monthly communion service when they will stay in the main service).

For those of Senior School age they will have their own meeting at least monthly in the Community Centre Office.
