Easyfundraising

Easyfundraising is a cashback scheme **that costs you nothing** to make an additional donation to our church. (i.e. our church). 8,000 retailers are part of Easyfundraising and includes Amazon, Tesco, Currys, Asda, John Lewis, Iceland, eBay, Apple, holiday companies (like Booking.com), airlines and lots more.

The retailer just needs to know you are an easyfundraiser to give a donation, and you do this by going to the easyfundraiser website, using its app or opt to have a 'Donation Reminder' pop-up when you log in on a retailer's site.
